

TRANSFERABILITY OF CONTACT HOURS

Contact hours earned at NHLA Inspector Training school may not transfer to another educational institution. Contact hours earned by another institution may not be accepted by the school. You should obtain confirmation that the school will accept any contact hours you have earned at another educational institution before you execute an enrollment contract or agreement. You should also contact any educational institutions that you may want to transfer contact hours earned at the school to determine if such institutions will accept credits earned at the school prior to executing an enrollment contract or agreement. The ability to transfer contact hours from the school to another educational institution may be very limited. Your contact hours may not transfer and you may have to repeat courses previously taken at the school if you enroll in another educational institution. You should never assume that contact hours will transfer to or from any educational institution. It is highly recommended and you are advised to make certain that you know the transfer of contact hours policy of the school and of any other educational institutions you may in the future want to transfer the contact hours earned at the school before you execute an enrollment contract or agreement.
