This is a Sustaining category business.

Sustaining membership is for individuals, firms or corporations who supply services, materials, or equipment to the active or associate members of this association or who are owners of North American hardwood timberlands providing the basic raw materials for the industry. Business types include but are not limited to: equipment manufacturers and dealers; insurance agencies; consultants; software developers; logistics and transportation providers; timberland owners. Membership Dues are \$1,300

This is an Associate category business.

Associate membership is for individuals, firms or corporations that are consumers of North American hardwood or cypress lumber, veneer, plywood and related products for manufacturing. Business types include but are not limited to: cabinet shops; furniture and flooring manufacturers; molding and millworks; pallet manufacturers. Membership Dues are \$1,300

I am an Inspector category who grades or inspects hardwood lumber for _____.

Inspector membership is for individuals who grade or inspect hardwood lumber for an active or associate category company but do not operate their own inspection service business. Membership Dues are \$75

This is a Research category membership.

Research category membership is for individuals or organizations that conduct North American hardwood forestry or hardwood forest products utilization research, or who have an interest in hardwood research results. Examples include state or federal forestry departments, educational institutions and hardwood utilization research agencies. Individuals – \$55 Institutions – \$190

This is a Partner category business

Partner membership is for individual firms or corporations engaged in consumption or manufacturing, custom kiln drying, wholesaling, or distribution of hardwood or cypress lumber, veneer, plywood and related products that have their headquarters outside of North America. Membership Dues are \$1,550.

Regulations Relating to Membership and Dues

The annual terms shall be a full year beginning on the first day of the month following the receipt of application. In the event member fails to pay all invoices rendered when due, member agrees to pay all costs of collection, including reasonable attorney fees. Contributions or gifts to the National Hardwood Lumber Association are not deductible as charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes. However, they may be tax deductible as ordinary and necessary business expenses.

The National Hardwood Lumber Association is a NOT-FOR-PROFIT association organized to promote the welfare and protect the interests of the North American hardwood trade.
